WHEREAS elected officials may participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund if their positions require 600 or more hours per year for the performance of their duties, and

WHEREAS the Wheeling Township Board of Trustees can determine the total normal annual hours of its part-time elected officials and should make such determinations for the guidance and direction of the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund Board of Trustees, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that effective March 22, 2016 the Board of Trustees of Wheeling Township finds that the position of Supervisor no longer meets the 600 hour requirement, and rescinds the section of Resolution 80-09 certified on June 17, 1980 that addresses the participation of the Supervisor position, and

FURTHER RESOLVED that the authorized agent is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund and that this resolution remain in full force and effect until rescinded, and the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund is notified in writing of the rescission.
