### OFFICIALS' REPORT

**ASSESSOR:** Assessor Jochum reported:

- Since this is actually a half month report I will focus mainly on the appeal session which has just ended.
- Tax Year 2021: The tax bills have been posted on the Cook County Treasurer website and the hard copies should be out by the end of November due at the end on December.
- Tax Year 2022: We opened for appeals with the County Assessor on October 10 and closed on November 10<sup>th</sup>. During the sessions we handled more than 1600

appeals for taxpayers. In addition to the appeal work, we handled exemptions, property characteristics and many other property issues. We utilized an outside resource to assist with input which worked successfully. In addition, we utilized an administrative only, extension for document input. Both of these steps are new methods of managing our workflow.

 BOARD REQUEST: Attached to this report is a request for the Board to approve a type of IGA which could be used between Assessors should there be additional manpower needs. The reason and use of the IGA is explained in the attached. Thank you for your consideration.

ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT: Administrator Stapleton reported:

- We are still looking for a Maintenance/Custodian, Senior Service Specialist, Home Delivered Meal Coordinator.
- Anthony Camacho, Cemetery Trustee, retired as of November 8, 2022. He had been a Cemetery Trustee for 12 years. We will begin looking for a new Trustee.
- Gertie, one of our Home Delivered Meals Clients turned 100 years last week. She has used our transportation, attending our VIP Support Group and was a Committee member when we had our Disabilities Council. Lynndah brought her flowers on behalf of the Township.
- Statistics for October 2022:
  - 1,697 rides- 383 non-medical, 1,314 medical 1,083 meals delivered 415 visits to the Food Pantry- 903 people fed
